
Space for detailing extra bookings:

*O*neeness with Jesus Christ unites us to each other: gathering into one all the redeemed in earth and heaven, "that they all may be one." There is no bond of union among men equal to that which binds Christians together as the children of their heavenly Father; for the members of the mystical body of Christ are in him united to each other in a manner similar to the union between the Father and the Son. It is incredible and inconceivable to the world how Jesus Christ breaks down every parting wall between his redeemed, not only in heaven but on earth, and knits heart to heart in the whole flock of the Good Shepherd. A mingled but beautiful flock, for "the wolf shall dwell with a lamb, and the leopard shall lie down with the kid; and the calf, and the young lion, and the fatling together; and a little child shall lead them."

In the day of our new birth we are "taught of God to love one another," and that not by mere commandment, but by love divinely planted in our hearts to all that are in Christ Jesus. We know them as we never thought it possible to know another; for the same Christ and the same Spirit are in us and in them. The very same truth that is in our heart is in theirs, the very same thoughts, the same fears, the same hopes, the same desires. Jesus Christ who has loved us has loved them as he has loved us, and Jesus Christ whom we love is loved by them as by us. If we love him we cannot but love them. The separation of country, of language, of rank, of age, of disposition is broken down; and we are united to them all by a bond that enters deeper into our heart and theirs than any other, that binds us closer together than any other, and that endures when all other bonds shall have given way.

Venue

Yarnfield Park is the home of the Banner Youth Conference. Situated in the village of Yarnfield in Staffordshire, and easily accessible from the M6, the purpose-built conference centre provides good facilities, including cafeteria-style catering, outdoor space for recreation, an on-site Costa coffee shop, and a gym.

Accommodation is in ensuite bedrooms, each equipped with a desk, tea and coffee making facilities, and super-fast wi-fi. Towels are provided.


